Dear Friends in Christ,

Women and men religious have ministered in parishes, schools, and organizations bringing the Gospel to life for decades. As I reflect on their ministry, I am grateful for the impact these women and men religious have had on the faith of people here in West Michigan.

In their years of ministry, they often served for little to no pay without retirement benefits. This means that many religious communities now have difficulty providing for the retirement and eldercare needs of their aging members.
